



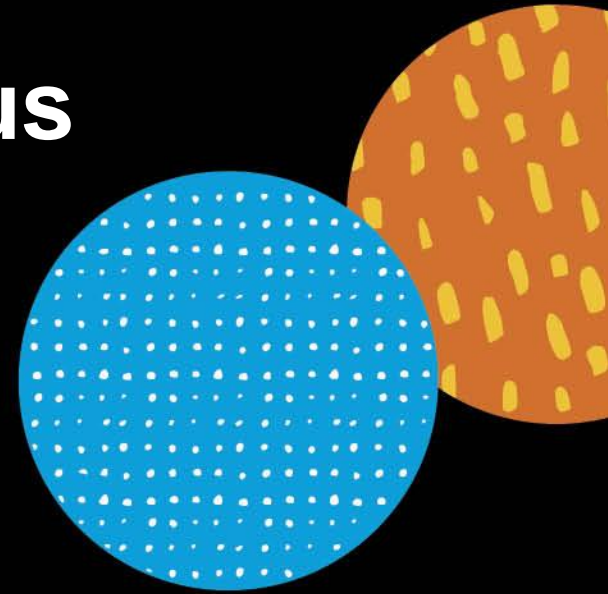

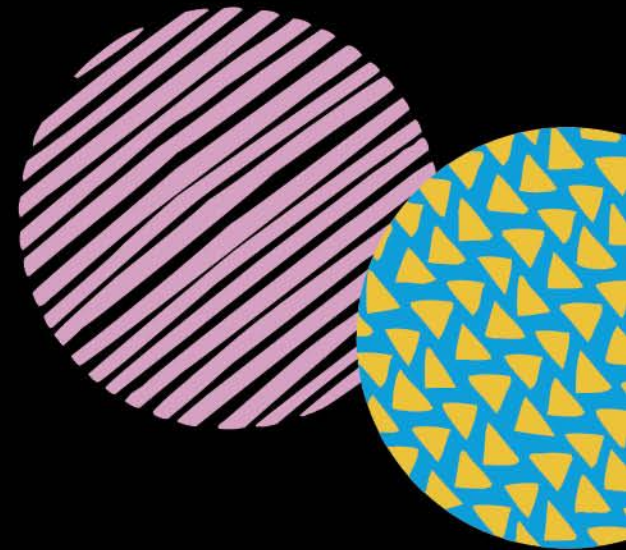
Youth Work is a big deal for us

- Keen supporter of Youth Work
- 2704 active grants, value £115.7M
- 60% portfolio - children 10+ years
- 636 active Youth Services projects cross-UK
- By number - 24% of portfolio
- Value £31.4M - 27% of portfolio
- Supporting a wide range of young people



Focus on Youth Work

- £2M Positive Destinations – education, employment, training
- £3M Fun & Friendship – disabled young people
- Youth Clubs review
- Speak Out Listen Up event



What have we learned?

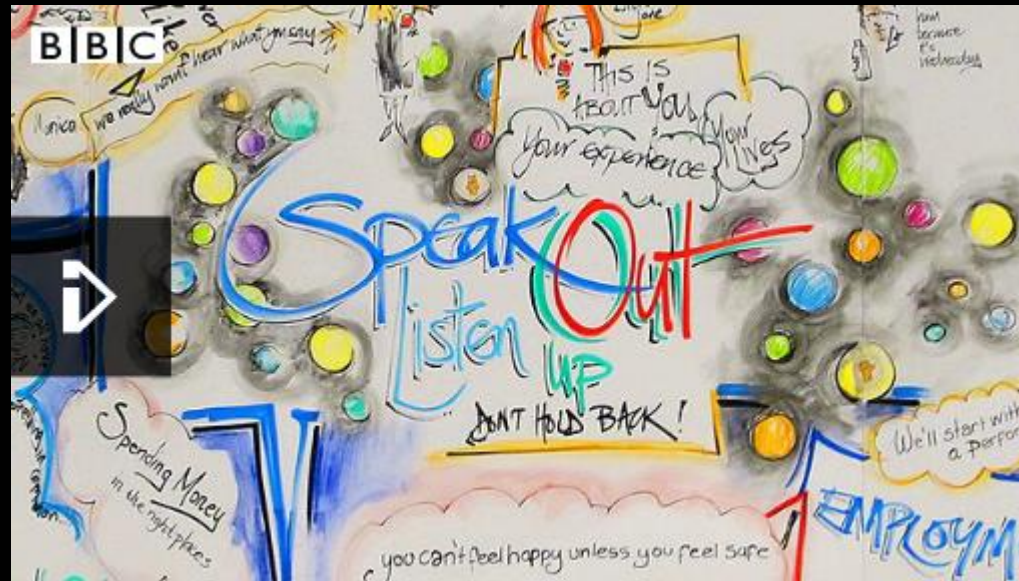
- Young people driving provision
