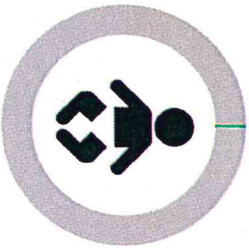
The health and wellbeing of children and young people (CYP) living in London

- Nearly **1 in 4** (2,039,600) of all people in London are CYP people under 20 years
- About **3 in 10** CYP in London live in poverty and about **1 in 7** live in poor housing

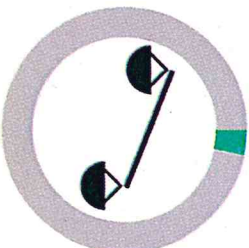
Mothers who smoked during pregnancy

5 year olds with tooth decay



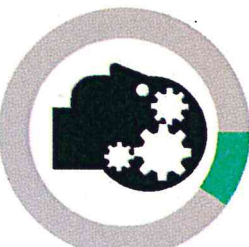
4-5 year olds who are overweight or obese



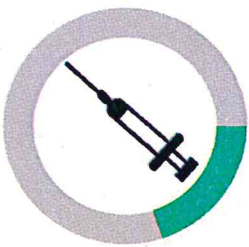
10-11 year olds who are overweight or obese
